As part of our responsibility under the charter we will offer the "Keeping God's Children Safe" lessons to your children once during this academic year. Monday, February 6th and Tuesday February 7th, we will present an age appropriate lesson at the beginning of your child's class time. The lesson reinforces the three key rules: say no, run away, tell a safe adult. This will be the only lesson presented to your child this year.

Parents are the most effective teachers of their children because they teach 24/7 and are continuously reinforcing what is important. The lesson that the catechists will teach presupposes that you continue to discuss these safety issues with your children.

Thank you for your kind cooperation in helping us adhere to the bishops' mandate to present these lessons which empower our children to be less vulnerable to perpetrators anywhere in our society.
